Purpose and Criteria for Nomination

PURPOSE

The purpose of the University Trainer of the Year recognition program is to recognize a University Trainer who has, during the immediate preceding year, demonstrated SUPERIOR enthusiasm, energy, presentation skills, and has embraced the GWRRA Training Philosophy.

CRITERIA FOR THIS AWARD

- Must be a current GWRRA member through the date of the award
- Must be a current University Trainer or
- The award is open to all University Trainers, Senior University Trainers, Master University Trainers and University Instructors regardless of their level.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- Any current GWRRA member or officer may nominate a University Trainer by submitting the University Trainer of the Year Nomination Form to their District Trainer. These are due to the District Trainer by March 31st.
- At the close of the of the Nomination Deadline the District Trainer will forward copies of the Nomination Forms to the District Educator and District MEPC.
- The District University Trainer Selection Team comprised of the District Trainer, District Educator, and District MEPC will select the winning District University Trainer of the Year.

- The Nomination Forms of the District University Trainer of the Year will be forwarded to the Assistant Region Trainer on or before the Nomination Deadline of June 30th.
- On the Nomination Deadline or when all District University Trainer of the Year Nomination Forms have been received, the Assistant Region Trainer will forward copies of the Nomination Forms to the Region Educator and Region MEPC.
- The Region University Trainer Selection Team comprised of the Region Trainer, Region Educator, and Region MEPC will select the winning Region University Trainer of the Year.
